

UP-STATE FARMS SOLD

New Yorkers Buy Estates in Goshen and Red Hook

Augusta Katz of New York City has purchased from the estate of Joseph P. McAdams the 154-acre "Sleepy Hollow Stock Farm" at Goshen, N. Y., through Samuel Gordon, broker of Florida, N. Y., according to Previews, Inc. The property includes a century-old white clapboard house, a hundred acres of meadowland and twenty acres of woodland.

In another transaction reported by Previews, Inc., in which Paul Ham of Hudson, N. Y., was the broker, the 257-acre dairy farm and orchard of Malcolm E. Cooper at Red Hook, N. Y., was purchased by Edward Lorang of New York City. The stock and equipment and a thirteen-room house were included in the sale.

Johann Goldberg of Brooklyn bought a ten-room lodge and 300 acres at Chichester, N. Y., from Mrs. Blanche Small, according to Previews, Inc. The fifty-year-old residence has a living room with exposed beam ceiling.
